NATIONAL GALLERY OF VICTORIA (NGV) AND HOSIER LANE

12th October, 2017

Introduction/Links to Curriculum:

As part of our Media Arts and ICT studies, the students in Year 6 will be visiting the National Gallery of Victoria (NGV) and Hosier Lane. At the National Gallery of Victoria, students will take part in the 'Abstractions Tour with iPads' program. They will have the opportunity to learn more about abstract art and discover how artists have used colour, shape, and line to explore and express ideas. An integral part of the 'Abstractions Tour with iPads' program involves the students using code to create their own ever-changing abstract work of art. In addition to their visit to NGV, the students will be taking a short walk to Hosier Lane where they will have the opportunity to view the fascinating graffiti-style art. Hosier Lane is perhaps the most famous of the street-art lane ways and is full of some of the best street-art Melbourne has to offer. Earlier this month, an artist's tribute to the Great War was mentioned in The Age. The mural depicts two images – one a fallen digger on the waterlogged Flanders Fields and the other shows a grieving woman at home in Australia, holding a letter.
