LAST MINUTE REMINDERS

Dear Parents,

Year 5 Camp to Ballarat/Creswick Log Cabin Resort is fast approaching. Please return all medical and dietary forms by **Friday 10th August** so that we can ensure your child is well-catered for.

Please ensure your child is at school at the shaded area (near the canteen) by 8.45am sharp on Tuesday 28th August 2018 to have their name marked off the roll. Buses are due back to school on Friday 31st August 2018 around 3.00pm. All students will be taken to the shaded area upon arrival. Students will not be dismissed from school until they have been signed out by a parent or guardian. Students will not be permitted to walk home unassisted that day. If you have concerns, please see your child's teacher.

- Before leaving home ensure **all** your child's belongings are clearly labelled. Luggage should be a soft sided bag or sausage bag, not a suitcase or hard framed backpack. Sleeping bags should be kept separate (not tied to other luggage) and clearly labelled. Please ensure that your child has packed a warm rain proof jacket.
- All medicines are to be clearly labelled with your **child's name and dosage instructions**. Hand all medicine and accompanying instructions to Mrs Court upon arrival at school on Tuesday morning.
- **Playlunch, lunch and drinks (preferably a refillable bottle of water) will be required Tuesday**. Please separate playlunch and lunch and pack in your child's small backpack or bag that they will be taking on the bus. Please ensure the drink bottle is clearly labelled with your child's name.
- Teachers attending the camp are Miss Churcher, Miss Reid, Mrs Court and Mr Rasasane. Parents and other staff attending camp are Miss Pearson (5JR student teacher), Miss Lin (Mandarin Assistant), Mr Kalalpitiye Gedara, Mrs Walker and Ms Wang.
- Students will be allowed to bring up to \$10.00 to be spent during our day excursion to Sovereign Hill. This will be the only time on camp that students will be allowed to make any form of purchase. This money is to be held onto by the child so please discuss with him/her the need for knowing where it is and being responsible for its safe keeping.
- Electronic devices such as handheld games, tablets, mobiles phones, and/or cameras are NOT permitted on camp.
