#### **Introduction/Links to Curriculum:**

As part of our Term 1 topic entitled 'Our Community', Year 1 students will be visiting the Casey Safety Village to learn more about the importance of road safety, where they'll be given a chance to ride bicycles, fire safety and the role of the CFA in our community.

The CFA Learning Centre provides students with an interactive program on home fire safety covering topics such as identifying fire hazards around the home, family home fire escape plans and how to extinguish clothing fires. Due to recent bushfire events, if your child has been adversely impacted by the fires (e.g. evacuation, affected by media coverage etc.), please contact your child's teacher.

They will also visit Casey Fields Play Space and Village Green (park) for lunch, where they will have the opportunity to explore a great community facility that includes an exciting playground.
