# Premiers' Reading Challenge – Closing Date Extended to 18<sup>th</sup> September

The Victorian Premiers' Reading Challenge is still open. TMPS is participating and all children are encouraged to join. It is not a competition, but a challenge for children to read a set number of books by the 18th September. It is **free to join**. So far, almost 2,000 books have been read by participating students.

Children in Prep, 1 and 2, need to read **30 books** (20 or more must be from the Challenge list). They can read books by themselves or have someone else read to them.

Children in year 3-6 will need to read **15 books** (10 or more must be from the Challenge list). Challenge lists are all available to view online.

All children who complete the Challenge will receive a certificate from the Premier of Victoria. As well, at TMPS all children who complete the Challenge will receive a small prize and be eligible to win some special prizes.

This year sees the launch of a new website with exciting new features. These include, having your own avatar, earning ebadges as you progress through the Challenge and giving books a rating or a review.

If you still wish to join, please contact TMPS via email or phone. We will then forward you a user name and passcode for your child. The child will be able to log onto the website and enter books they read or start exploring what the new website offers. TMPS will verify all books for you.

It may be a little more challenging to access reading material at the moment, but here are a number of suggestions to make it a little easier. Keeping up with reading for learning or pleasure is really important, especially at this time.

- For young children, search YouTube for 'read a picture book', and listen to dozens of children's books like *The Lorax*, *The Very Hungry Caterpillar* and *The Rainbow Fish*.
- Watch your favourite authors read their books at [The Big List of Children's Authors Doing Online Read Alouds and Activities](#).
- Watch astronauts on the Space Station read children's books at [Storytime from Space](#).
- Stream videos of authors reading children's books with illustrations at [Storyline Online](#).
- Listen to a [David Walliams audio book](#).
- Download a free classic children's or young adult's book from [International Children's Digital Library](#) or [ManyBook.net](#)
- **Local Library.** If you are a member, you can access online resources for free. Some of their free online resources include, Storybox Library, Tumblebooks and Borrowbox.. They also have online storytime, read by staff, to watch. If you are not a member, it is free to join and you will be able to access a world of books and resources for free. Contact your local library for more details.

In term 3 Book Club will still provide the opportunity to purchase books for children. The process is different so please read the following information.

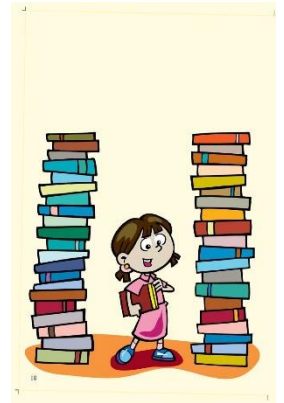
- **Orders will be ONLINE ONLY** and directly via the parent portal **LOOP**. NO orders can be made through Thomas Mitchell P.S.
