INTRODUCTION/LINKS TO CURRICULUM:

Since the beginning of the year, students from Year 4 have been enthusiastically participating in a weekly music and dance program. As a culmination of their time working in this program the students and teachers would like to invite family and friends to see the students perform a short concert at Rivergum Primary School Arts Centre, in the grounds of Hampton Park Secondary College.

Performing is an important part of the Arts where unique, expressive, creative and communicative forms engage students in critical and creative thinking which helps them understand themselves and the world around them. The past 10 weeks have allowed the students to really enjoy music and singing as well as develop some confidence and 'stage presence'. We hope that all students in Year 4 will participate on the night.



Participants/Classes: All Year 4 classes

Date: Wednesday 19th May, 2021

Concert Times: The Performance will start at 7.55pm and will run for approximately 45 minutes.

Students performing will be required to arrive at 7.30pm.

Doors to the theatre will be open for seating at 7.35pm.

Students must be checked off a class list by their classroom teacher at the end of the performance before they can leave the venue with a parent/guardian. Children will not be permitted to walk home.

Ticketing: This is a ticketed event to comply with COVID19 Regulations. Tickets are free of charge. All family members are welcome to view the performance, but there is limited seating. Disabled access and seating is available.

- All family (audience) members attending must individually enter their details when booking the tickets (name and contact number)
 - o If booking more than 1 ticket, please ensure that you have names and phone numbers for each person that you are booking for
- Tickets must be presented at the door on the night (either a copy on your phone or a printed copy)
- It is general seating (i.e. not assigned seating)
- If you are also attending the Year 2 concert (prior to the Year 4 concert), you MUST book tickets for the Year 2 concert separately using a different booking code <https://www.trybooking.com/BRCIU>
- Masks are recommended as physical distancing is not possible

Tickets DO NOT need to be purchased for the students who are performing.
