The past 12 weeks have allowed the students to really enjoy music and singing as well as develop some confidence and 'stage presence'. We hope that all students in Year 4 will participate on the night.

Concert Times: The Performance will start at 7.45pm and will run for approximately 45 minutes.

Students performing will be required to arrive at 7.15pm.

Doors to the theatre will be open for seating at 7.25pm. Please refrain from entering the theatre until after the Year 2 concert has finished. Disabled access and seating is available.

Tickets are not required for this event. All family and friends are welcome to view the performance.

There is ample street parking around the venue. However, it is requested that parents do not park in the school car park.

Students must be checked off a class list by their classroom teacher at the end of the performance before they can leave the venue with a parent/guardian. Children will not be permitted to walk home.
