PARENT PAYMENT REQUESTS FOR 2026 YEAR 5

Thomas Mitchell Primary School is looking forward to another great year of teaching and learning and would like to advise you of the school's voluntary financial contributions for 2026.

Schools provide students with free instruction to fulfil the standard curriculum requirements and we want to assure you that all contributions are voluntary. Nevertheless, the ongoing support of our families ensures that our school can offer the best possible education and support for our students. We want to thank you for all your support. This has made a huge difference to our school and the programs we can offer.

Within our school parent support has allowed us to offer a wide range of subjects and additional programs and resourcing such as:

- Building on, and updating our Digital Technologies, including iPads, student notebooks and robotics and ensuring a student ratio of at least 1:2
- Maintenance of Information Technology devices and employment of support personnel
- Extension program, Tutoring Learning
- Enrichment opportunities
- Science and STEM specialist programs
- Enhancing our Literacy and Numeracy programs with access to online technologies and the provision of Learning Specialists to support staff and student learning
- A well resourced Library with a qualified Librarian
- Enhancing our Arts program in the areas of Visual Arts and Performing Arts classroom specialists
- Employment of a qualified and experienced Registered Nurse
- Upgrading and maintaining split system air conditioning to all classrooms
- Employment of a Wellbeing Coordinator to support student wellbeing and engagement throughout the school
- Installation of playground soft fall to replace mulch and refresh of sand in the student sand pit
- Painting of some classrooms
- Installation of a second Soccer pitch, from fundraising monies
- Access to communication software (Compass) to facilitate consents and payments of events, notifications of health centre attendances, unexplained absences including student safety matters, conferences, etc.

In 2026, we would like your support to help us continue improvement projects such as:

- Maintenance & upgrade to our Fake Grass, Soccer Pitch areas and improvement of school gardens and grounds
- Continued employment of a Registered Nurse to manage our health centre and first aid needs
- Continued employment of a Wellbeing Coordinator to support student wellbeing and engagement, and the implementation of social skills program
- An Environmental Program, including extension of our vegetable garden
- A new playground for our Early Learning Centre area
- Updating our basketball courts
- Renovation of male and female student toilets.

IMPORTANT DATES FOR ORDERING AND DELIVERY ARRANGEMENTS, INCLUDING ADDITIONAL CHARGES. EXTENDED FREE DELIVERY ARRANGEMENTS DUE TO HIGHER COSTS FOR YEARS 3, 4, 5 & 6.

ORDER BY MIDNIGHT, FRIDAY 16TH JANUARY. Free school delivery direct to your child's classroom, ready for the start of the school year (Years 3-6 only).

Guaranteed delivery to school for the start of school in 2026, no delivery or packaging fee.

FROM SATURDAY 17TH JANUARY 2026

• Orders placed from 17th January 2026 are no longer eligible for school delivery and will be delivered to home addresses. These will incur a packing & delivery fee of \$9.95 which includes a \$3 home delivery surcharge. (Please note the supplier will endeavour to supply all items, however some stocks may not be available). **Delivery before** school starts is not guaranteed.

More details are on the following pages, with instructions to order. Please ensure you select the book pack appropriate to your child's 2026 year level.

If also ordering for younger siblings in Years Prep, 1 & 2, please feel free to spread the costs by placing each child's orders at different times to take advantage of the early bird discounts. There is an earlier date for discounts and late order fees for the younger year levels. For example, the early bird discount ends on Friday 7th December for Years Prep, 1 & 2. This information is available in the Parent Payment Requests for 2026 letters specific to each year level.

2. IF YOU PURCHASE YOUR CHILD'S BOOKS FROM ANOTHER SUPPLIER:

If you purchase your child's books from another supplier of your choice, we ask that you purchase all books listed and <u>match the descriptions</u> shown. This will ensure your child will be working with books of the same standard and requirements as other children in the class.

Please make arrangements to pay the school directly for your child's online subscriptions and any optional items.

<u>Please send these books to school with your child ready for their first day of school in 2026 and arrange to make payment directly to the school for online subscriptions and other optional items.</u>

FREE INSTRUCTION

- Schools provide students with free instruction and ensure students have free access to all
 items, activities and services that are used by the school to fulfil the requirements of the
 Curriculum. This includes the Victorian Curriculum F-10, the Victorian Certificate of
 Education (VCE) including the VCE Vocational Major and the Victorian Pathways Certificate.
- Schools may invite parents to make a financial contribution to support the school.

PARENT PAYMENT REQUESTS

Schools can request contributions from parents under three categories:



Curriculum Contributions

Voluntary financial contributions for curriculum items and activities which the school deems necessary for students to learn the Curriculum.

Other Contributions

Voluntary financial contributions for non-curriculum items and activities that relate to the school's functions and objectives.

Extra-Curricular Items and Activities

Items and activities that enhance or broaden the schooling experience of students and are above and beyond what the school provides for free to deliver the Curriculum. These are provided on a user-pays basis.

• Schools may also invite parents to supply or purchase educational items to use and own (e.g. textbooks, stationery, digital devices).



FINANCIAL HELP FOR FAMILIES

- Schools put in place financial hardship arrangements to support families who cannot pay for items or activities so that their child doesn't miss out.
- Schools have a nominated parent payment contact person(s) that parents can have a confidential discussion with regarding financial hardship arrangements.



SCHOOL PROCESSES

Schools must obtain school council approval for their parent payment arrangements and publish all requests and communications for each year level on their school website for transparency.







Here's what you need to know to place your order.

New and Returning Users

Already Registered? If you ordered school supplies last year, you don't need to create a new account. Simply go to www.booklistorders.com.au and reset your password.

New Users? First, go to www.booklistorders.com.au to register. Make sure to use the school code TMP26 when creating your account.



When you create your password, it must be at least 12 characters long and include:

- An uppercase letter (A-Z)
- A lowercase letter (a-z)
- A number (0-9)
- A special character (!@#\$%^&*)

For example: Booklist123!

Once you've set your password, check your email for a verification link. Click the link to activate your account and view pricing.

Early Order Savings & Deadlines

Place your order by **midnight on January 16th 2026** to secure **discounted pricing** negotiated for our school community and free school delivery.

Important Novel Bundle Exception:

This year, we're introducing a combined **compulsory novel bundle** for **Years 3, 4, 5, and 6**. To allow time for this change, we are granting an extension for these year levels.

The final date to submit your booklist order without any late fees is now **midnight**, **January 16th** for students in Years 3, 4, 5, and 6.

Delivery Information

Early Orders:

Orders placed by January 16th midnight, will be delivered directly to Thomas Mitchell Primary School prior to the commencement of Term 1.


Late Orders:

Please note that any orders placed **from January 17th onwards** will *no longer* be eligible for School Delivery. These orders will be processed as **Home Delivery only**, and the late fee will be **\$9.95** to include the new home shipping and packing charges.

How to Place Your Order

- 1. Log in to your account. Select your child's year level (Prep to Year 6).
- 2. View Pack Details. The ordering page a full list of all items to be expected in your book pack. Years 3,4,5 and 6 will also have a visual image of your Novel Bundle.
- **3.** Add Your Student's Name. Please make sure to add your student's name on the ordering page. If you have multiple children, add each student's name and their book pack separately. This helps the school track which families have placed orders.
- **4. Optional Extras** These items are all required but may be retained from previous years. Only opt in and tick the items you require if they need to be replaced.
- **5. Contributions.** Your support makes a significant difference. Please opt into the contributions you wish to make to support your child's education.
