PARENT PAYMENT REQUESTS FOR 2025 YEAR 3

Thomas Mitchell Primary School is looking forward to another great year of teaching and learning and would like to advise you of the school's voluntary financial contributions for 2025.

Schools provide students with free instruction to fulfil the standard curriculum requirements and we want to assure you that all contributions are voluntary. Nevertheless, the ongoing support of our families ensures that our school can offer the best possible education and support for our students. We want to thank you for all your support. This has made a huge difference to our school and the programs we can offer.

Within our school parent support has allowed us to offer a wide range of subjects and additional programs and resourcing such as:

- Building on, and updating our Digital Technologies, including iPads, student notebooks and robotics (rather than ask parents to provide under a Bring Your Own Device program) and ensuring a student ratio of at least 1:2
- Extension program, Tutoring Learning
- Enrichment opportunities
- Science and STEM specialist programs
- Enhancing our Literacy and Numeracy programs with access to online technologies and the provision of Learning Specialists to support staff and learning
- A well resourced Library with a qualified Librarian
- Enhancing our Arts program in the areas of Visual Arts and Performing Arts classroom specialists
- Employment of qualified and experienced School Nurses
- New shade sails outside the Performing Arts classroom
- Upgrading and maintaining split system air conditioning to all classrooms
- Employment of a Wellbeing Coordinator to support student wellbeing and engagement throughout the school
- Installation of playground soft fall to replace mulch
- Painting of some portable classrooms
- Installation of a second Soccer pitch, from fundraising monies

In 2025, we would like your support to help us continue improvement projects such as:

- Provisioning and maintenance of Information Technology Devices and employment of support personnel, ensuring a minimum of 1:2 ratio (students to devices)
- Ensuring access to communication software (Compass) to facilitate payments of events, notifications of health centre attendances, unexplained absences, including student safety matters, conferences, etc
- Additions to our playground equipment
- Maintenance to our Fake Grass, Soccer Pitch areas and improvement of school gardens and grounds
- Continued employment of qualified staff to manage our health centre and first aid needs
- Continued employment of a Wellbeing Coordinator – to support student wellbeing and engagement, and the implementation of social skills program
- An Environmental Program, including extension of our vegetable garden
- Renovation of male and female student toilets.

In the following pages, we have listed our requests in detail. They are broken down into 3 categories.

Please note we are also suggesting parents of students in years 3 to 6 make a contribution for the **School Sports Affiliation costs**, which cover the cost of affiliation and coordination of sports programs at the District, Divisional, State and Nationwide levels for children in years 3 to 6. The school pays in excess of \$8000 for these fees. Without it, our children would not have opportunities to participate in external sporting activities.

When making payments, please ensure you obtain a receipt for your reference and any enquiries.

REFUNDS

Parent requests for refunds are subject to the discretion of the school and are made on a case by case basis. Refunds will be provided where the school deems it is reasonable and fair to do so, taking into consideration whether a cost has been incurred, the Department's Parent Payment Policy and Guidance, Financial Help for Families Policy and any other relevant information.

PAYMENTS TO PURCHASE YOUR CHILD'S BOOKS AND OTHER ITEMS

There are a number of ways to make electronic payments at times when it suits you.

1. IF YOU PURCHASE YOUR CHILD'S BOOKS AND PAY VIA OUR PREFERRED SUPPLIER:

We recently called for a number of suppliers to tender for the provision of student books and materials for our school. We have selected Office Corporate as our preferred supplier on the basis of their reputation, costs, provision of particular brands and the quality of the materials they supply.

For convenience and certainty of acquiring the correct book materials, we recommend you purchase through our preferred supplier, Office Corporate.

IMPORTANT DATES FOR ORDERING AND DELIVERY ARRANGEMENTS, INCLUDING ADDITIONAL CHARGES

ORDER BY MIDNIGHT, TUESDAY 10TH DECEMBER. An 'early bird' discount is also offered on the book packs.

- Guaranteed delivery to school for start of school in 2025, no delivery or packaging fee.

FROM WEDNESDAY 11TH DECEMBER TO FRIDAY 17TH JANUARY 2025

- Orders placed FROM Wednesday 11th December but prior to 11.59pm Friday 17th January 2025 will incur a packing fee of \$2.75 and a late fee of \$6.95. These orders are still guaranteed to be sent directly to school ready for the first day of school in 2025.
- Early bird discount is no longer available.

AFTER 18TH JANUARY 2025

- Orders placed from 18th January 2025 will be delivered to home addresses and will incur a packing fee of \$2.75, and a shipping/late fee of \$9.95. (Please note the supplier will endeavour to supply all items, however some stocks may not be available). **Delivery before school starts is not guaranteed.**

More details are on the following pages, with instructions to order. **Please ensure you select the book pack appropriate to your child's 2025 year level.**

2. IF YOU PURCHASE YOUR CHILD'S BOOKS FROM ANOTHER SUPPLIER:

If you purchase your child's books from another supplier of your choice, we ask that you purchase all books listed and **match the descriptions** shown. This will ensure your child will be working with books of the same standard and requirements as other children in the class.

Please send these books to school with your child ready for their first day of school in 2025 and arrange to make payment directly to the school for online subscriptions and other optional items.

To purchase online subscriptions and other optional items we request you make payment direct to the school on the following dates:

1. If making payment to the school please arrange to pay over the phone or come into the school office any time during school hours between:
MONDAY 18TH NOVEMBER 2024 TO WEDNESDAY 18TH DECEMBER 2024
2. If you prefer to pay in 2025, we ask that you come into the school office or pay by phone once school has commenced. Payment can be made at the school office (or via phone) during 8.30am and 4.30pm on school days any time from Thursday 30th January.

Payment during school days outside of the above times is acceptable, however please be advised that you may experience short wait times.

ONE PAGE OVERVIEW



FREE INSTRUCTION

- Schools provide students with free instruction and ensure students have free access to all items, activities and services that are used by the school to fulfil the requirements of the Curriculum. This includes the Victorian Curriculum F-10, the Victorian Certificate of Education (VCE) and the Victorian Pathways Certificate.
- Schools may invite parents to make a financial contribution to support the school.



PARENT PAYMENT REQUESTS

Schools can request contributions from parents under three categories:

Curriculum Contributions

Voluntary financial contributions for curriculum items and activities which the school deems necessary for students to learn the Curriculum.

Other Contributions

Voluntary financial contributions for non-curriculum items and activities that relate to the school's functions and objectives.

Extra-Curricular Items and Activities

Items and activities that enhance or broaden the schooling experience of students and are above and beyond what the school provides for free to deliver the Curriculum. These are provided on a user-pays basis.

- Schools may also invite parents to supply or purchase educational items to use and own (e.g. textbooks, stationery, digital devices).



FINANCIAL HELP FOR FAMILIES

- Schools put in place financial hardship arrangements to support families who cannot pay for items or activities so that their child doesn't miss out.
- Schools have a nominated parent payment contact person(s) that parents can have a confidential discussion with regarding financial hardship arrangements.



SCHOOL PROCESSES

- Schools must obtain school council approval for their parent payment arrangements and publish all requests and communications for each year level on their school website for transparency.
